These 8" x 8" personalized bricks will be laser engraved with the inscription of your choice (up to 6 lines, up to 20 characters per line including spaces, and clip art/logo if you choose) for \$50.00. These tribute bricks are perfect for honoring your family name, celebrating a precious memory, or memorializing a loved one. This brick will forever leave your legacy at Asbury United Methodist Church while helping raise funds to make other aspects of the exterior project possible.
